It is also defined as the branch of sociology which studies the age, sex, caste, religion, language and distribution of human population.

## Methods of Demography

- 1. Direct method: Data received from VRS, Census, Sample Survey etcare considered as direct methods.
- 2. Indirect methods: Indirect methods are used to estimate demographic indicators like fertility rate, mortality rate, migration rate, etc when data found from census and sample survey are defective.

The sources of population data are primary data sources and secondary data sources.
