Child Marriage in Nepal

Child marriage is a marriage among boy and girl who are before 18. In context of Nepal, it can be seen more practical before few years. Nowadays also, it is in practice in rural area. A report has shown that Nepal has one of the highest rates of child marriage in Asia. Globally, it is counted as social evil but in poor countries. It is a very common social problem. Getting marriage in early age can arouse trouble for both male and female not economically and socially but it effects physically too.

The reason behind child marriage in Nepal seems complex poverty, the low value attached to daughters and lack of access to education are the main factors of early marriage or child marriage. All those factors are connected with the lack of education. The bad concept of (kanyadan) handing over daughter before menstruation can make the parents to stay in heaven after their death is a major superstition. The wrong concept of daughter should engage in household activities, they should not be sent to the school are the other superstition about child marriage. In this context I asked my grandmother, she told me that she got married at the age of 11 and my grandfather was 14 years old. Due to early age my grandmother faced miscarriage and gave birth to her first child at the age of 14. My grandmother is the perfect example of our society.

Due to child marriage female suffers a lot from reproductive disease. The major effect of child marriage is, it ends childhood. It negatively influences children's rights to education, health and protection. These consequences impact not just the girl directly but also her family and community. A girl who is married as a child is more likely to be out of school and not earn money and contribute to the community.

Dashain

Festival is the public event. Hindu people celebrate this festival in Asoj or Kartik. The main festival of Hindu is Dashain. In, English calendar, this festival generally falls in the time of September or October. All the students, employee and officers get a long public holiday on the occasion of Dashain. The celebration occurs during the bright lunar for tonight ending on the day of the full moon at Dashain.

People go to their relative house to put tika, jamara and they receive a lot of blessings. The last day of Dashain is Khojagaat Purnima.
